Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the respondents, particularly Respondent No.3 and other police officials of Lalaguda Police Station, Hyderabad, in repeatedly calling the petitioner to the police station, making him and his parents sit for long hours without registering any FIR, without issuing any notice under law and without following due process, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the personal liberty of the petitioner except by following due process of law;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents, particularly Respondent No.3 and his subordinates, not to call the petitioner to the police station, harass, detain, or interfere with the personal liberty of the petitioner in any manner except by following the due process of law and in accordance with the provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, pending disposal of WP No 18956 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Md Fasiuddin, Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME, for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Learned Government Pleader for Home, appearing for the respondents seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

List this matter on 24.06.2026 in the Adjourned Motion List.

In the meantime, the respondents are directed not to call the petitioner to the Police Station without there being any justifiable cause.
