Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of Respondent Nos. 3 to 5, acting at the instance and in collusion of Respondent Nos. 6 to 9, in interfering with the Petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of their agricultural land to an extent of Ac. 3-19 Gts in S.No. 198/A3 of the 1st Petitioner and Ac. 3-19 Gts in S.No. 198/A1 of the 2nd Petitioner situated at Nizampet Medipally Village, Pudur Mandal, Vikarabad District totalling an extent of Ac. 6-38 Gts, as being illegal, arbitrary, void ab initio, and violative of Articles 14, 21, and 300A of the Constitution of India, and consequently

direct the official respondents not to interfere with the Petitioners peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said agricultural lands.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the official respondents to provide necessary police protection to the Petitioners to safeguard their peaceful possession from any illegal encroachment or interference by Respondent Nos. 6 to 9, or anyone person acting on their behalf, over the agricultural land to an extent of Ac. 3-19 Gts in S.No. 198/A3 of 1st petitioner and Ac. 3-19 Gts in S.No. 198/A1 of and petitioner situated at Nizampet Medipally Village, Pudur Mandal, Vikarabad District, pending disposal of WP No 19003 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The writ petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri N Purushotham Reddy Advocate for the Petitioners and GP for Home for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondents No. 1 to 5, seeks time to get instructions in the matter.

List this matter on 24.06.2026 in the Adjourned Motion List.

In the meantime, the respondents No. 1 to 5 are directed not to call the petitioners to the Police Station without there being any justifiable cause.
