Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the respondents in considering and acting upon the representations dated 27.04.2026, 07.05.2026 and 22.05.2026 as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently direct the respondents to remove the unauthorized encroachment upon the public footpath which is effecting the petitioner shop and take necessary action against the hazardous cooking activities being

carried on with firewood stoves in accordance with the provisions of the GHMC Act and other applicable laws.

ORDER : (ORAL)

Grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents' authorities are not considering his representations dated 27.04.2026, 07.05.2026 and 22.05.2026 for removal of unauthorised encroachment of footpath at Gowtham Nagar, Dilsukhnagar, by respondent No.5.

2. The grievance of the petitioner is that neighbouring shop owner let-out his property to respondent No.5 and respondent No.5 has encroached the footpath abutting his shop and is preparing food

items by using firewood stoves and open flames, thereby causing smoke, health hazard and nuisance to the petitioner as well as pedestrians. Hence, the petitioner lodged several complaints requesting respondent Nos.1, 2, 3 and 4 to take necessary action against respondent No.5, however, no action is being taken by them.

3. Heard Mr. Jillela Rajeshwar Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner; and Mr. Srinivas Rao Pachva, learned Standing Counsel for Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation; and perused the material on record.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, respondent No.3 - the Deputy Commissioner, Saroornagar, Circle No.12, Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad, is directed to consider the petitioner's representation dated 22.05.2026 by issuing a notice to all the interested persons and by affording an opportunity of hearing to them and to pass orders on merits within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Notice to respondent No.5 is dispensed

with, however, if respondent No.5 is in any way aggrieved by this order, he is at liberty to approach this Court seeking modification of this order as this order is passed without entering into merits of the case. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of, at the admission stage itself. No order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any, pending in the writ petition stand closed.

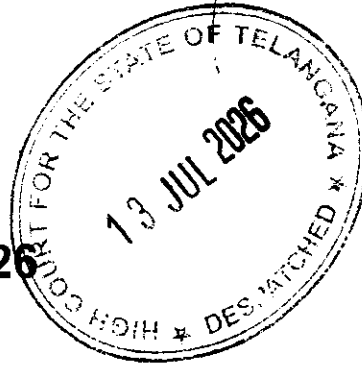
