Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of respondent Nos. 2 to 5 in allotting, handing over or seeking to utilize the petitioners' lands in Sy. Nos. 132 and 134 of Mailardevpally Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, to the 2nd respondent for construction of water tank and allied works, with the aid of respondent No. 6 and police force, under the false pretext that the work pertains to Sy. No. 133, by encroaching upon the petitioners' lands in Sy. Nos. 132 and 134, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently direct the respondents not to interfere with the petitioners' peaceful possession and enjoyment of the said lands.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere with the peaceful possession of the petitioners' land in Sy. Nos. 132 and 134 of Mailardevpally Village, Rajendranagar Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, under the pretext of government land in Sy. No. 133 for the construction of water tank and allied works by respondent no. 2, pending disposal of WP No.19041 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, learned senior counsel represents for Mr. Ramulu Pasupula Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR MCPL ADMN & URBAN DEV for the Respondent No.1, Sri A. Veeresh Kumar, standing Counsel for the respondent No.2, ASST GP FOR REVENUE, for the respondent Nos. 3 to 5 and GP FOR HOME, for the respondent No.6, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Heard Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, learned senior counsel appearing for Mr. Ramulu Pasupula, learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submitted that in the earlier round of litigation in WP.No.18542 of 2022 filed by the petitioners against the revenue officials and third parties, interim order was passed on 13.04.2022 for limited period and thereafter, the interim order was extended until further orders vide order dated 06.09.2022.

Learned senior counsel further submitted that the grievance of the petitioners is that the respondent authorities herein are interfering with the possession of the petitioners on the pretext of construction of water tanker, alleging that the land of the petitioner is Government land.

In the light of the above submissions and the order passed in WP.No.18542 of 2022, there shall be interim direction to the respondents No.2 to 5 not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioners in respect of lands in Sy.Nos.132 and 134 of Mailardevpally Village, Rajendranagar Manal, Ranga Reddy District, without following due process of law. However, this order shall not come in the way of the respondent

authorities in issuing notice to the petitioners and conducting survey for demarcating the lands of the petitioners in Sy.Nos.132 and 134 and Government land in Sy.No.133, Mailardevpally Village.
