Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ declaring the action of irrigation authorities under the provisions of Telangana Irrigation Act XXVI of 1357 Fasli and the authorities of HMDA under the provisions of HMDA Act 2008 in demarcating the extent of Abu Kunta situated in S.No. 79 of Nagireddyguda village, Moinabad as 15.66 acres, as without jurisdiction, illegal and arbitrary and contrary to the principles of natural justice as being without notice.
