Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate Writ, Direction, order or orders, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents more specially, respondent no.2 in insisting respondent no.3 vide order dated- 08.12.2025 to take personal bond from the petitioner, and consequent action of respondent no.3 in issuing notice to the petitioner vide Form 12, to execute a Bond for keep the peace for a term of 12 months or until the completion of inquiry in the matter of law and order pending vide C.No.110 of 2026, U/s 126 of BNSS for an amount of rupees one lakh, dated- 08.12.2025, without passing order in writing as stipulated under section 130 of BNSS, and subsequently issuing notice to the petitioner, dated- 17.04.2026 to execute another Self-Bond for good behaviour U/s 126 of BNSS, by virtue of a report filed by respondent no.2, dated-15.04.2026 with same set of allegations and without passing order in writing as stipulated under section 130 of BNSS, is illegal, arbitrary, and violation of Article 14,16, 21 of Constitution of India and also violation of principles of Natural Justice and consequently

i) set aside the notice issued by respondent no.3 to the petitioner vide form 12 for execution of personal bond dated- 08.12.2025 and

ii) set aside the notice issued by respondent no.3 to the petitioner for forfeiture of bond for good behaviour U/s 126 dated- 17.04.2026 and

iii) set aside the further proceedings pending before respondent no.3 in C.No.110/2026 and

iv) direct the respondent no.3 authority to release the bond amount of Rupees One Lakh to the petitioner.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to:

i) suspend the notice issued by respondent no.3 to the petitioner vide form 12 for execution of personal bond dated- 08.12.2025 and

ii) suspend the notice issued by respondent no.3 to the petitioner for forfeiture of bond for good behaviour U/s 126 dated- 17.04.2026 and

iii) suspend further proceedings pending before respondent no.3 in C.No.110/2026, pending disposal of WP No 19245 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI SIRIPURAM KAUMUD Advocate for the Petitioner, AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents no. 1 and 2, and AGP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent no.3, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 and the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and waives further notice.

In view of the waiver, Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondents No.1 to 3.

List this matter on 23.07.2026.

In the meantime, notice for forfeiture of bond dated 17.04.2026 shall not be acted upon.
