Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to under the caption For Being Mentioned/modify the interim order dated 19.06.2026 passed in I.A. No.1 of 2026 in W.P. No.19213 of 2026, by substituting directions (i), (ii) and (iii) thereof with the following:

- (i) The petitioners-institutions are permitted to collect the fee proposed for block period A. Y 2022-23 to 2024-25 i.e., Rs.99,000/- for B. Tech course and Rs.60,000/- for MBA course, for A. Y 2026-27, pending disposal of the present writ petition.
- (ii) The Convener, TGEAPCET, is directed to display in the official website that the fees will be Rs.99,000/- for B. Tech course and Rs. 60,000/- for MBA course, for A.Y. 2026-27, which was proposed by the petitioners-institutions for the block period A.Y. 2025-26 to 2026-28, subject to the result of the present writ petition.
- (iii) The Convenor, TGEAPCET, shall communicate the present interim order to the prospective students seeking admission for the A.Y. 2026-27 into the petitioners-institutions, clearly indicating that the fees payable by the students shall be Rs.99,000/- for B. Tech course and Rs.60,000/- for MBA course, for A.Y. 2026-27, which was proposed by the petitioners-institutions, subject to the result of the present writ petitions, pending disposal of WP No.19213 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

I.A.No.1 of 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to permit the Petitioner No 2 Institution to collect the fee of Rs 99,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs. 60,000/- per student per annum for the MBA course as proposed by the Petitioner No 2 Institution, as otherwise the Petitioners would suffer grave and irreparable loss, pending disposal of WP No 19213 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and the order of the High Court order dated 19.06.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of mentioned counsel.

The Court made the following,

ORDER:

Heard Mr. S.Sriram, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr.Vinay Krishna Kodali, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr. B.Mayur Reddy, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr. G.Chandra Shekar Reddy,

learned Standing Counsel for TAFRC and Mr. Mallu Nethan Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader attached to the Office of the learned Additional Advocate General.

Considering the submissions made by the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners and for the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, the Registry is directed to substitute paragraph Nos.9 and 11 of the interim order, dated 19.06.2026 passed in I.A.No.1 of 2026 in W.P.No.19213 of 2026, which read as follows:

“Hence, learned Senior Counsel prayed this Court to permit the petitioners-institutions to collect the fee of Rs.95,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.45,000/- for MBA course, which was tentatively agreed at the time of personal hearings conducted on 08.03.2025 and 29.08.2025, for A.Y. 2026-27, pending disposal of the present writ petition and further requested this Court to direct the Convener, TGEAPCET, to display in the official website and communicate the present interim order to the prospective students seeking admission for the A.Y. 2026-27 into the petitioners-institutions, clearly indicating that the fees may be increased from Rs.95,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.45,000/- for MBA course, which was tentatively agreed by the TAFRC at the time of personal hearings conducted on 08.03.2025 and 29.08.2025 to Rs.99,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.60,000/- for MBA course, which was proposed by the petitioners-institutions for A.Y. 2025-28, subject to the result of the present writ petition.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners, in view of the law laid down by the erstwhile High Court of Andhra Pradesh in the aforesaid judgment and considering the fact that the counseling process has already commenced and even if the matters are remanded to TAFRC for fresh consideration, no effective relief would ensue as the fee structure is likely to remain unchanged, therefore, as an interim measure, this Court is inclined to issue following directions:

(i) *The petitioners-institutions are permitted to collect the fee of Rs.95,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.45,000/- for MBA course, for A.Y. 2026-27, pending disposal of the present writ petition.*

(ii) *The Convener, TGEAPCET, is directed to display in the official website that the fees to be collected per student is Rs.95,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.45,000/- for MBA course and the said fees may be increased to Rs.99,000/- for B.Tech course and Rs.60,000/- for MBA course, subject to the result of the present writ petition.*

(iii) *The Convener, TGEAPCET, shall communicate the above order to the prospective students seeking admission for the A.Y. 2026-27 into the petitioners-institutions.*

The Registry is further directed to issue a modified copy of the order forthwith.

Accordingly, this application is allowed.
