Heard Mr.V.Ram Mohan Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.V.Jithender Rao Veeramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1 and Mr.U.Jagan, learned counsel for respondent No.2. Learned counsel for both the parties submit that at the instance of elders and well-wishers, the petitioner and respondent No.2 have entered into a settlement and filed applications vide I.A.Nos.2 and 3	Transferred to i.o. folder before corrections, if any.

of 2026 seeking to compound the offence and record the compromise. Along with the said applications, both parties have also filed a joint memo.

During the course of hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that, even before the filing of the present Criminal Petition, the Investigating Officer, after conducting the investigation, had filed the final report before the Special Sessions Judge for trial of cases under the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, L.B. Nagar and S.C. number is awaited.

Learned counsel for the parties further submits that the parties will appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee for identification.

In view of the above said submission, Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the High Court Legal Services Committee immediately.

Hence, the petitioner and respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on or before 10.07.2026. On such appearance, the High Court Legal Services Committee is directed to submit a report before this Court on or before the next date of hearing.
