CONTEMPT CASE No. 1587 OF 2019

ORDER:

This Contempt Case is filed alleging violation of the orders dated 18.06.2018 passed by this Court in I.A.No.1 of 2018 in W.P.No.164 of 2018.

2. By the above said order, this Court granted interim orders on 18.06.2018 directing the parties to maintain status-quo with regard to the construction permissions and regularization applications in the lands to an extent of Ac.13-22 guntas, situated in Sy.No.592 and 593 Part, Old Alwal Village, Alwal Circle 27.

3. After receipt of the notices in the contempt case, a counter affidavit has been filed by respondent Nos.1 to 3 stating that in view of the interim orders passed by this Court, they have not accorded any building permission in survey numbers mentioned in the writ petition nor they regularized any buildings under BRS scheme, as such there is no willful and deliberate violation on the part of the respondents as stated by the petitioner.

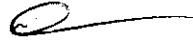
4. In these circumstances, this Contempt Case is closed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner, if any cause

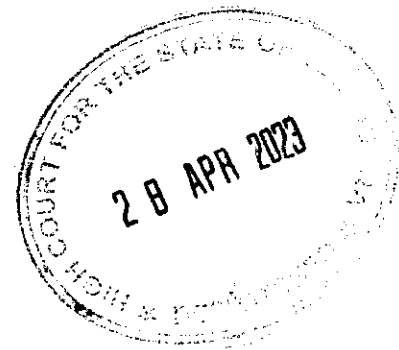
