Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in issuing the impugned Notice No. UC-152/TPS/CMC/AMEE-47/2026 dt 12-6-2026 for demolition of the construction made in premises bearing H.No. 5-94/152 on Plot No. 152 in Sy.No. 48/EE, situated at Srujana Lakshmi Nagar, Phase-III of Patelguda village, Ameenpur Mandal, Sangareddy District, without properly considering the explanation/reply dt.30-4-2026 submitted to the show cause notice dt. 16.4.2026 bearing Notice No. UC-152/TPS/CMC/C47/2026, without jurisdiction, contrary to the documents on record, and violative of the principles of natural justice and Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently set aside the same, and to grant such other relief or reliefs as this Honble Court deems fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant stay of all further proceedings pursuant to the impugned Notice No. UC 152/TPS/CMC/AMEE-47/2026 dt. 12-6-2026 issued by the 3rd respondent, pending disposal of WP No 19885 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Umapathi Sarma Advocate for the Petitioner, Government Pleader for MA&UD for Respondent No.1 and Sri Putta Krishna Reddy, Standing Counsel for Respondent Nos.2 & 3, and the Court made the following.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the respondents are directed to maintain *Status quo* pursuant to the impugned order dated 12.6.2026.
