Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 6th, 7th and 8th official respondents are forcibly-trying to dispose the petitioner and family members from petitioner property by threatening to handover the possession to unofficial respondent by invoking the petitioner and family members in multiple crimes without following due process of law and without any valid reasons basing on the complaint lodged by the respondent No.9 in FIR'S No. 737 of 2026 is illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.6 to 8 not to interfere with the personal liberty and meddling with possession of the Petitioner property by

threatening and making attempts to disposing the petitioners from property without following due process of law in the interest of justice.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.6 in restraining the registration of multiple FIR's against petitioner and family members with same set of facts and cause of action, pending disposal of WP No 19983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.1 to 5 to give protection to the petitioner and family members against the respondent no.9 in meddling with possession of subject property, pending disposal of WP No 19983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

I.A. NO: 3 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.2 & 3 to act upon the representation given by petitioner dated 01.06.2026 order enquiry against the respondents no. 6 to 8 and unofficial respondent and placed before this Hon'ble court for appropriate action against the respondents no. 6 to 8 for interference of the petitioner property, pending disposal of WP No 19983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

I.A. NO: 4 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent No.6 & 7 to release the vehicles (TS 08 UE 7919 & AP 29 CC 1566) and handover to petitioner, pending disposal of WP No 19983 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VEERA BABU GANDU Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents no. 1 to 6, the Court made the following.
