Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by declare the action of Respondents in interfering with the right of enjoyment of the Petitioner over the land admeasuring Ac. 14.86 cents comprised in Sy.Nos.25/1, 29/3, 24/1, 26/2A of Morrapudi village covered by Registered Sale Deed bearing Document No. 2108/2001 dated 26.06.2001 which is under provisional attachment as per G.O.Ms.No. 212 (Annexure - IV) Home (General B) Department dated 22.09.2001 as illegal, arbitrary in violation of Article 300-A of Constitution and in violation of provisions of Protection of Depositors of Financial Establishments Act, 1999 and consequently direct Respondents not to interfere with the right of enjoyment of the Petitioner over the land admeasuring Ac. 14.86 cents comprised in Sy.Nos.25/1, 29/3, 24/1, 26/2A of Morrapudi village covered by Registered Sale Deed bearing Document No. 2108/2001 dated 26.06.2001.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass an interim direction restraining Respondents from interfering with the right of enjoyment of the Petitioner over the land admeasuring Ac. 14.86 cents comprised in Sy.Nos.25/1, 29/3, 24/1, 26/2A of Morrapudi village covered by Registered Sale Deed bearing Document No. 2108/2001 dated 26.06.2001 which is under provisional attachment as per G.O. Ms.No. 212

(Annexure - IV) Home (General B) Department dated 22.09.2001, pending disposal of WP No 21705 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI BIKKI RAVEENDRA BABU Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR HOME for the Respondents No. 1 and 2 and GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondent No.3, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and waives further notice.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice on behalf of respondent No.3 and waives further notice

Registry is directed not to take out notice to the respondents No.1 to 3 in view of the above waiver.

The petitioner has filed a memo dated 20.07.2026 enclosing therewith a copy of the report given by the Horticulture Officer, Nuzvid Mandal, Eluru District, the Mandal Agricultural Officer, Nuzvid Mandal, Eluru District and the Village Revenue Officer, Meerjapuram Village, Nuzvid Mandal, to the effect that the petitioner is cultivating the subject land and there are nearly 200 coconut trees therein and that there is a black gram crop in one acre and some brinjal plants are there in part of the subject land and the balance land is vacant.

In view of the same and also as the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home seeks time to get instructions on the said information given by the petitioner, list on 12.08.2026 for getting instructions and also for filing of counter and till such time, petitioner shall be allowed to take care of the standing crop and the coconut trees.

Petitioner shall not claim any equities by virtue of this order.
