ORDER

This Civil Revision Petition is filed seeking a direction to the learned Senior Civil Judge-cum-Chief Judicial Magistrate, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kukatpally for speedy disposal of the O.S.No.226 of 2021.

2. Heard Mr. V.S. Sudhakar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Srinivasa Rao Bodduluri, learned counsel for the respondent.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a senior citizen and the suit was originally filed in the year 2018. The said suit has been pending for more than seven years. At present, the suit is coming up for further chief-examination of PW-1. In the meanwhile, the respondent has filed an implead petition and the petitioner filed detailed counter and the same is coming up for hearing.

4. In the said circumstances, the petitioner filed the present Civil Revision Petition seeking a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and dispose of the O.S.No.226 of 2021 on the file of the learned Senior Civil Judge-cum-Chief Judicial Magistrate, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kukatpally at the earliest.

5. Learned counsel for the respondent did not oppose the same.

6. In view of the above circumstances, the learned Senior Civil Judge-cum-Chief Judicial Magistrate, Medchal-Malkajgiri District at Kukatpally is directed to conclude the trial and dispose of the O.S.No.226 of 2021 as expeditiously as possible and the parties to the *lis* are directed to co-operate with the Trial Court without seeking any undue adjournments.

6. With the above said direction, this Civil Revision Petition is allowed. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel, miscellaneous applications pending, if any, in this Petition, shall stand closed.
