ORDER

1. This Memorandum of Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 480 and 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS) praying this Court to enlarge the petitioner-A1 on bail in connection with F.I.R. No.1134 of 2025 of Chandanagar Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate. The offences alleged against the petitioner-A1 are punishable under Sections 8(c) r/w 20(b)(ii)(c) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 ("NDPS Act").

2. Heard Sri P. Vikasraj, learned counsel for petitioner-A1 and Sri D. Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for respondent-State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner-A1 submits that no contraband is recovered from the possession of petitioner-A1, alleged seizure was made from the possession of co-accused and petitioner-A1 was not apprehended at the scene of offence. A2, A3 and A5 are enlarged on bail. Petitioner-A1 is a woman aged about 40 years and she is working as Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) and prayed to enlarge petitioner-A1 on bail.

4. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that charge sheet is filed before the concerned Court on 20.05.2026.

5. On the complaint lodged by LW.1-Khaja Moinuddin, Sub-Inspector of Police, Chandanagar PS, FIR came to be registered against Korra Buliki and others.

6. Remand case dairy dated 22.04.2026 goes to show that petitioner-A1 was arrested on 20.04.2026 at 11:00 hours and she is produced before the concerned Court for remand. Remand case dairy further goes to show that A2-Korra Buliki, A3-Pangi Venkat and A5-Sembi Divya Rani are arrested on 07.10.2025 at 15:30 hours and are produced before the concerned Court for remand.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner-A1 on instruction submits that A2 and A3 are enlarged on bail by this Court vide orders dated 10.03.2026 in CrI.P.Nos.2827 and 2829 of 2026 respectively.

8. Since the charge sheet is filed against A1, A2, A3 and A5, detaining the petitioner-A1 further will not serve the purpose for the prosecution. Petitioner-A1 is entitled for bail, subject to the following conditions:

- i. The petitioner-A1 shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only), with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge, Ranga Reddy District at L.B. Nagar.
- ii. The petitioner-A1 shall not commit similar offences while on bail.
- iii. In the event of violation of the above condition, the prosecution is at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.

9. Accordingly, this Criminal Petition is allowed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed.
