ORDER:

Heard Mr.V.Sreenivasa Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner and Ms.K.Swapna Madhuri, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Medical Health appearing for respondent Nos.1 and 2, Mr.T.Sharath, learned Standing Counsel for KNRUHS appearing for respondent No.3.

2. This writ petition is filed seeking following prayer:

“to issue Writ order or direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in withholding the original certificates on the completion of DM Nephrology contrary the directions of this Hon’ble court in W.A. No.1422 of 2025 under the guise of G.O. Ms. No.165 of 2017 dated 06/09/2017 issued for Compulsory Resident Specialist postings for Super Specialty Post Graduates as illegal arbitrary and in violation of Article 14 19 21 254 of Constitution of India consequently to direct the respondents to release all original documents of petitioner”

3. Today when the matter has been taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in similar facts and circumstance a

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division bench of this Court in W.A.No.1422 of 2025 dated 28.04.2025,
passed the following order:-

"11. In the light of the aforesaid discussion, this Writ Appeal is allowed. The impugned order dated 30.07.2025 in W.P.No.15250 of 2025 is set aside. W.P.No.15250 of 2025 is allowed. Respondent No.8-College is directed to return the original certificates i.e., i)Permanent Medical Registration Certificate (MBBS & PG); ii) Permanent MBBS Degree Certificate; iii) Provisional PG Degree Certificate; iv) Internship Completion Certificate; v) Bonafide Certificate (MBBS & PG); Vi) Conduct Certificate (MBBS & PG); vii) SSC/CBSE (10th) Marks Memo; viii) 12th Marks Memo; ix) MBBS Marks Memo/consolidated Memo; x) PG Marks Memo/Consolidated Memo; xi) Transfer Certificate; and xii) Migration Certificate, to the appellant under due acknowledgement, within one (1) week from the date of receipt of a copy of this Judgment.

As sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any pending in the Writ Appeal shall stand closed. There shall no order as to costs."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further pray this Court to pass similar orders as passed in W.A.No.1422 of 2025 dated 28.04.2026

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader appearing for respondents did not dispute the same.

6. Recording the submission made by learned counsel appearing on either side and in terms of order passed by this Court in W.A.No.1422 of 2025 dated 28.04.2026, this writ petition is disposed of directing the Respondent No.3-College to return the original certificates, to the

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petitioner under due acknowledgement, within one (1) week from the date of receipt of a copy of this Judgment.

7. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. No order as to costs.

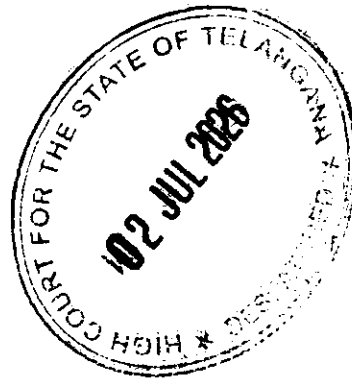
