WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his/her Advocate Sri KHAMMAM SRINIVAS presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to.

a) Issue a Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of the Respondent Nos. 1 to 7 in

providing police protection to the Petitioner as illegal, arbitrary, and violative of Articles 14, 19(1)(g), and 21 of the Constitution of India

b) Consequently, direct the Respondent Nos. 1 to 7 to forthwith provide adequate and effective round-the-clock police protection, including armed gunmen, to the Petitioner, his family members, and for his business operations in Peddapalli District immediately and without further delay for the protection of his life, limb, and lawful business.

c) Consequently, direct the Respondents to ensure that no unlawful obstruction is caused to the Petitioner's lawful gravel transport business operations in Turkalamaddikunta, Mallapur villages and Peddapalli Mandal, and that the Petitioner be permitted to operate his business peacefully in accordance with the law and his valid permits.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. KHAMMAM SRINIVAS Advocate for the Petitioner and GP for home, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 7, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 8 & 9, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 11.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

**I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 1 to 7 to provide immediate and effective interim armed police protection to the Petitioner, his family, and his business, to safeguard him from the imminent threat to his life and limb, and to ensure no obstruction to his lawful business, as an urgent interim relief, pending disposal of WP No 20459 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

**The Court made the following:**

**ORDER**

**Notice before admission.**

**Learned Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondents 1 to 7 and waives further notice.**

**Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondents 1 to 7 in view of this waiver.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondents 8 and 9 by speed post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in spite of several representations, the respondents have not taken any action nor did they provide police protection to the petitioner from the unofficial respondents 8 and 9 who have threatened the petitioner from carrying on his work as contractor. It is further submitted that on 12.07.2026, the petitioner's driver was also beaten up and threatened and therefore, he has made a representation today to the Peddapalli rural police, but the same has not been received by the SI of Police, Peddapalli Rural Police Station.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home was directed to get instructions. He submitted that though the petitioner was called to the police station, he had sought time saying that he would come and give complaint.

In view of the repeated opportunities being given to the official respondents to get instructions, they have not been able to get information. The petitioner being 100% visually impaired person and is complaining that he is receiving threats for his life for carrying on his work, the respondent police are directed to give police protection to the petitioner.
