01.	30.06.2026	<u>SKS, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Dispensed with. <u>I.A.No.2 of 2026</u> This application is filed by the petitioner praying this Court to suspend the sentence imposed vide Judgment dated 11.06.2025 passed in C.C.No.372 of 2022 by the learned III Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, at Mahabubnagar and confirmed by the appellate Court vide Judgment dated 24.06.2026 passed in CrI.A.No.38 of 2025 by the learned Principal Sessions Judge, at Mahabubnagar, wherein the petitioner was found guilty for the offence punishable under Section 326 of the IPC and was convicted and sentenced to undergo R.I. for a period of 03 years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- and in default of payment of fine, to undergo Simple Imprisonment for a period of 01 month. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that there are good grounds for the petitioner to succeed in the revision. It is further contended that though there is no evidence on record to prove the allegations against the petitioner, both the trial Court and the appellate Court erroneously convicted the petitioner. As such, requested this Court to suspend the sentence passed by the trial Court and confirmed by the appellate Court and release the petitioner on bail. On the other hand, learned Additional Public	Tr. to I.O/daily orders folder before corrections, if any.

	Prosecutor opposed bail stating that there is no flaw in the judgment of trial Court and there are no grounds to consider this application. Hence prayed this Court to dismiss this application. In view of the submissions made by both the counsel and material on record, considering the facts and circumstances of the case this application is allowed suspending the sentence alone imposed by the trial Court and petitioner is granted bail till disposal of this revision, and shall be released on bail, subject to the petitioner executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of learned III Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, at Mahabubnagar.
