Learned counsel Sri Shreyas Reddy.Y appears for the appellant.

Sri Ananthula Ravinder, learned Government Pleader for Social

2. The present appeal is filed against the interlocutory order dated 25.06.2026 whereby W.P.No.19930 of 2026 filed by the appellant was directed to be listed on 09.07.2026 i.e., tomorrow. However, the grievance of the appellant is that the prayer for interim suspension of the public notice dated 20.06.2026 whereby the Telangana Waqf Board has taken the custody of the Management of the Masjid-e-Top-Ka-Sancha also known as (Masjid-e-Aliya) with Graveyard Rajjab Ali and its attached properties, was not taken up for consideration despite the urgency in the matter.
3. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the impugned interlocutory order though, on the face of it, appears to be innocuous, but on account of the non-consideration of the prayer for interim suspension, the appellant would suffer serious consequences.
4. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the appeal is not maintainable against an interlocutory order where the matter has only been posted for the next day i.e., tomorrow. Therefore, this court may not interfere in the matter.

5. On hearing learned counsel for the parties and the immediate background facts compelling the appellant to prefer the appeal against the interlocutory order of adjournment on the ground that its application for interim suspension against the impugned public notice dated 20.06.2026 was not taken up by the learned writ court, we are of the view that since the main matter is posted tomorrow, the learned writ court can be requested to take up the appellant's prayer for interim suspension as well.

6. The instant appeal is, therefore, disposed of with a request to the learned writ court to consider the appellant's prayer for interim suspension made in I.A.No.1 of 2026 in W.P.No.19930 of 2026 after hearing the other side, who are the official respondents. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed.

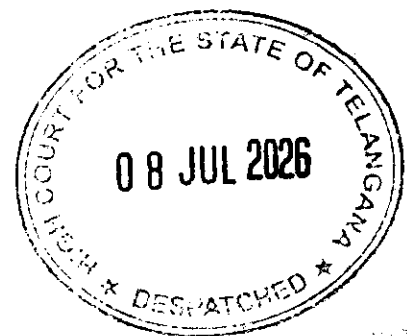
