Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Nampally, Hyderabad (earlier registered as FIR No. 41 of 2026 on the file of Rein Bazar PS), and quash the same by allowing the Criminal Petition as prayed for. *please*

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. SHIREEN SETHNA BARIA Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the respondent No. 1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

ORDER

Notice to the respondents.

Learned Public Prosecutor, High Court for the State of Telangana takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and waives further notice.

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent No.1 in view of this waiver.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by speed post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service.

It is submitted that W.P.No.16776 of 2026 is filed against FIR No.124 of 2026 on the file of Central Crime Station, Detective Department, Hyderabad (earlier registered as FIR No.41 of 2026 on the file of Rein Bazar Police Station), FIR No.62 of 2026 of Mirchowk Police Station and FIR No.86 of 2026 of Madannapet Police Station, registered against the petitioners herein and this Court has already granted interim direction not to take any coercive steps against the 1st petitioner company and this Criminal Petition is filed by the Directors and employees of the 1st petitioner company who have subsequently been arrayed as accused and the learned Senior Counsel appearing for the petitioners is seeking interim protection to the petitioners herein.

Learned Public Prosecutor is also heard.



Having regard to the interim direction given in W.P.No.16776 of 2026 dt.29.05.2026, the same interim order shall continue to operate in this Criminal Petition as well. However, this order shall not come in the way of the investigation being done against the petitioners herein.
