WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri C Hari Preeth presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, to declare the illegal action of the respondents, particularly 2nd respondent to 4th respondents herein, and rejected the petitioner candidature and not allowing the petitioner to opt the web option / online to choosing of law colleges, and enable to get the admission into the 3 years Law Course in the respondents colleges or its affiliated colleges, in-spite of petitioner submitted all the original certificates, i.e., 1) SSC(TOSS), 2) Intermediate (TOSS), 3) Degree (BA), 4) TS LAW CET and PGL CET-2019 Common Entrance Test Hall Ticket No.1190201650, 5) TS LAW CET-2019 Rank Card (Rank.8062) including other necessary certificates, pursuant to Schedule for Decentralised Certificate Verification on 30.09.2019 issued by the respondents, and same is illegal, arbitrary, unjust, rejection of admission, it's nothing but violation of Fundamental Rights, i.e., Article 14, 15 and 19 including Right to get the Education under Constitutional Law, and consequently direct the respondents herein, forthwith grant/give the admission to the petitioner, in-respect of 3 years LLB Course in the respondents colleges or its affiliated Law Colleges for the Academic year 2019-20;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri C Hari Preeth Advocate for the Petitioner, and learned Government Pleader for Higher Education who takes notice for respondent No. 1 and Sri Ch. Jagannatha Rao, learned standing counsel who takes notice for the respondents No. 2 to 4, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 5, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 07.11.2019 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is also permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No. 5 by registered post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service into the Registry.

Learned Government Pleader for Higher Education takes notice for respondent No. 1 and Sri Ch. Jagannatha Rao, learned standing counsel, takes notice for respondent Nos 2 to 4 and they both waive further notice.

Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 in the light of this waiver.
