Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein, forthwith reserve the one 3 Years LLB Seat in any Government Law College or its Affiliated Law Colleges for the Academic year 2019-20, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition No.22656 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

**IA NO 2 OF 2019:**

Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents herein, grant / Give the admission to the Petitioner, in-respect of 3 years LLB Course in the respondent colleges or its Affiliated Law College for the Academic year 2019-20, pending disposal of the main Writ Petition No.22656 of 2019, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

**ORDER:**

"The present writ petition is filed challenging the action of respondent No.4 in not considering the candidature of the petitioner for admission into 3-Years Law Course through Web option/online in the respondents colleges on the ground that the petitioner is not eligible for seeking admission in law course, as she has not completed the qualifying exam in prescribed pattern i.e., (10 + 2 + 3), while the petitioner has completed the qualifying examination in the pattern 10 + 3 + 2.

Heard Sri Hari Preeth, learned counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Higher Education, Sri Ch. Jagannatha Rao, learned Standing Counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 4, Sri G.M. Mohiuddin, learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.5, and Smt. S. Nanda, learned Standing Counsel for impleaded respondent Nos.7.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for petitioner that batch of writ petitions with similar subject are pending before this Court, wherein interim orders have been granted and draws attention of this Court to the interim orders granted by this Court in W.P.No.37566 of 2016 and W.P.No.35460 of 2016.

The said fact is not disputed by the learned counsel for the respondents. However, learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.7 submits that Rule 5 of Legal Education Rules, 2008 and, in particular, Rule 5(a) and 5(b) of the Rules have been considered by a Full Bench of Madras High Court and the said Full Bench had taken a contrary view.

However, having regard to the pendency of similar matters before this Court, I see no reason to take a different view from the view taken in the batch of writ petitions pending before this Court. Further, the petitioner has also filed an affidavit undertaking that by virtue of such permission being granted to prosecute 3-Year Law Course, she will not claim any right to practice as an Advocate upon obtaining 3-Yar Law Degree, if interim order is granted in her favour and she will abide by the final result in the writ petition.

Considering the same, there shall be a direction to respondent No.4 to permit the petitioner to participate in the process of web counselling/online and to provide admission, if she is otherwise found eligible without regard to objection on educational qualification."
