Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent No.7 in issuing NOC No. LSDA File No. A4/82 Petroleum/Cyberabad dated 27/9/2025 and consequential Licence issued by the 2nd respondent vide Licence No. P/SH/TG/14/10179(P614074) dt. 30-10-2025 for establishing Retail petrol & Diesel Outlet situated in Sy.No. 345, Admeasuring 0-38 guntas situated at Vattinagulapally Village, Gandipet Mandal, Ranga Reddy District is illegal arbitrary contrary to law and Violation of Rule 144 of Petroleum Rules, 1934 and set aside the same and consequently direct the respondents 2 to 7 to cancel the Licence issued vide No. P/SH/TG/14/10179(P614074) dt. 30-10-2025 to the respondent No.10 and not to permit to proceed further by the 10th respondent in the petitioners land stated above.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay of all further proceedings pursuant to NOC No. LSDA File No. A4/82 Petroleum/Cyberabad Police, issued by the 7th respondent dated 27-9-2025 and consequential Licence issued by the 2nd respondent vide Licence No. P/SH/TG/14/10179(P614074) dt. 30-10-2025 to the 10th respondent for establishing Retail petrol & Diesel Outlet situated in Sy.No. 345, Admeasuring 0-38 guntas situated at Vattinagulapally Village, Gandipet Mandal, Ranga Reddy District pending disposal of WP No 21402 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Ravendar Samala Advocate for the Petitioners, Sri Janardhan Goud Sunkari (Central Govt.. ORDER

There shall be interim direction to the respondents No.3 and 7 to consider the representations of the petitioner, sent through registered post dated 18.05.2026, seeking cancellation of NOC issued to the respondent No.2 for operating petrol and diesel retail outlet in Sy.No.345, Vattinagulapally

Village, Gandipet Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, by affording opportunity of personal hearing to the petitioner and the respondents No.8 to 10 and pass orders, in accordance with law, within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
