WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI K RAMA SUBBA RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to declare the action of the 2nd Respondent in not releasing the fine amount of Rs. 6,85,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs eighty five thousand only) as ordered in CrI.A.No. 1695 of 2018 by this Hon'ble Court convicting the accused for the offence U/Sec. 138 N.I. Act and imposing a fine of rupees equivalent to cheque amount i.e., Rs. 9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine lakhs only) and as confirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in S.L.P. (CrI) No. 4484 of 2023 and consequently deposited by the accused and ordered to paid by the trial court i.e., II Additional Metropolitan Magistrate, R.R. District, L.B. Nagar with a Token Number 2603288095, dated 09/02/2026 as illegal, arbitrary by issuing appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly in the nature of Mandamus and consequently direct the 2nd Respondent to release the amount of Rs. 6,85,000/-(Rupees Six lakhs eighty five thousand only) in respect of Token Number 2603288095, dated 09/02/2026 forthwith.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. K RAMA SUBBA RAO Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
