Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ or order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus Declare the Proceedings No. Plg-I/12/SDF-10Cr/ 2023-24 dated 01.06.2025, proposing to disburse funds for the construction of an SC Madiga Community Centre over the land admeasuring Ac. 2.20 Gts., in Sy. No. 72/1/2 (wrongly shown as 72/1/8) situated at Battisavargoan Village, Mavala Mandal, Adilabad District, thereby illegally and handedly trying to change the nature of the said land is as illegal, arbitrary and violation of the status quo orders passed by this Honorable Court in I.A. No.1 of 2023 in W.P. No.14153 of 2023 and the ad-interim injunction orders dated 22.05.2023 in I.A. No.4 of 2023 in O.S. No.114 of 2023 passed by the Honorable Principal Junior Civil Judge, Adilabad apart from being violative of the Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and constitutional goal of classless and casteless society Consequently direct the Respondent Nos.2 to 6 not to disburse funds for the construction of an SC Madiga Community Centre over the land admeasuring Ac. 2.20 Gts., in Sy. No. 72/1/2 situated at Battisavargoan Village, Mavala Mandal Adilabad District direct the

Respondent Nos. 7 not to grant building permission and/or to allot house number to the proposed construction over the Subject Lands direct the respondent Nos. 8 to 10 not to provide electricity connection in respect of subject lands.
