ORDER

This Writ Petition is filed alleging inaction on the part of respondent No.3 in acting upon the complaints submitted by the petitioner dated 12.02.2026, 18.02.2026 and 18.03.2026.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondents No.1 to 3.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home has furnished a copy of the written instructions received by him and submitted that pursuant to the complaint lodged by the petitioner on 12.02.2026, F.I.R.No.156 of 2026 has been registered for the

offences punishable under Sections 351(2), 351(3), 270, 352, 131, 61(2), 126 and 115(2) read with Section 3(5) of BNS against unofficial respondents and that the investigation is in progress. It is further submitted that, thereafter, the petitioner lodged another complaint on 18.02.2026 alleging destruction of the CCTV camera and continuation of threats and another complaint on 18.03.2026 in continuation of the allegations made in the above criminal case. It is stated that the investigation is being carried out in the said cases. It is further submitted that respondent No.3 issued a notice dated 15.02.2026 under Section 94/179 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, to the petitioner to produce all the relevant documents and details of independent witnesses in connection with the above case. It is stated that, after completion of the investigation, an appropriate final report shall be filed before the competent Court in accordance with law.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, in response to the notice dated 15.02.2026 under Section 94/179 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, the petitioner has already furnished all the relevant documents, but no action has

been taken by the respondent-police against the unofficial respondents. It is further submitted that the investigation is not being conducted.

5. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, this Court deems it fit and proper to direct respondent No.3 to complete the investigation expeditiously, strictly in accordance with law, and file the appropriate final report before the competent Court.

6. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, pending shall stand closed.

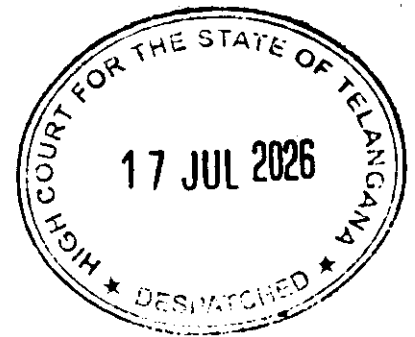
