WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI KARUNAKAR REDDY, presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 1st respondent in issuing the impugned G.O.Rt.No. 637 dt. 11/5/2026 to the extent of appointment of the 3 respondent as a member of the Telangana Womens Commission who is admittedly not a blood relative of Chakali Iamma, as being illegal, arbitrary, unjust and unconstitutional and consequently set aside the same by directing the respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider the Petitioners case for appointment as Member of the Telangana Womens Commission in her capacity as the legal heir and successor of the late Chakali Iamma.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI KARUNAKAR REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.1 to 3, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
