O R D E R

This Criminal Petition is filed under Sections 480 & 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') by the petitioner/Accused seeking to enlarge him on bail in connection with Crime No.92 of 2026 of Ramgopalpet Police Station, Mahankali Division, Secunderabad. The offences alleged against the petitioner are punishable under Sections 69 and 78 of the BNS.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the *de facto* complainant lodged a report before police on 03.05.2026, wherein she stated that for the last six months she came into contact with the petitioner, who is friend of her sister

Sania. They developed a good friendship, and after about three months, the victim expressed his love upon her and promised that he would marry her. Believing his promise to be genuine, she accepted his proposal. Under the pretext of marriage, they entered into a physical relationship on several occasions over the last three months. It is stated that when she is getting stomach pain, she checked pregnancy test and result was positive. When the same was informed to the petitioner, he completely changed his behavior and he refused to marry her, started avoiding her, abused her in filthy language and pressured her to take abortion. Hence, she requested the police to take necessary action against the complaint. Basing on the same, police registered a case for the aforesaid offences.

3. Heard Sri P.Vineel Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioner/Accused and Sri D.Arun Kumar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing for the respondent-State.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner is innocent of the offences alleged against him and he has been falsely implicated in this case and there is no such incident had occurred as

alleged by the complainant; that the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 05.05.2026; that whatever relationship between the parties is a consensual one; that material part of the investigation is completed and hence, he prays this Court to grant regular bail to the petitioner-accused.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the same and submits that the offences alleged against the petitioner are grievous in nature; that investigation is still pending and hence, he prays to dismiss the petition. However he informed the Court that the statement of the victim under Section 183 of the BNSS was already recorded.

6. Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the petitioner has been in judicial custody since 05.05.2026. As seen from the record, L.Ws.1 to 15 were examined and statement of victim under Section 183 of the BNSS was also recorded. Considering the period of incarceration, nature of allegation and progress in investigation, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner-accused subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The petitioner-accused shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the learned XXII Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate at Secunderabad.
- (ii) On such release, the petitioner-accused shall appear before the concerned S.H.O. between 09:00 a.m., and 5:00 p.m., on every Wednesday for a period of eight (8) weeks or till filing of charge sheet whichever is earlier, for the purpose of investigation, and thereafter, as and when required.
- (iii) The petitioner-accused shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 437 (3) of Cr.P.C. (presently, Section 480 (3) of BNSS).

7. Accordingly, the Criminal petition is allowed.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand closed.
