Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to SUSPEND the operation of the Order and Decree dated 05.08.2024 passed in I.A. No. 286 of 2024 in O.S. No. 160 of 2016 on the file court of the Principal Senior Civil Judge at Mahabubnagar, Pending disposal of CRP No. 2560 of 2024, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case). The Court made the following

ORDER

Learned counsel for the revision petitioner is present.

Sri Chaitanya, Advocate, submitted that he filed Vakalat today to appear on behalf of the respondent No.2 and he intends to file counter in I.A.No.1 of 2024.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the revision petitioner contended that the Trial Court, without considering the counter filed by the petitioner herein, had

erroneously allowed the I.A.286 of 2024 filed by the respondents and the petitioner has got good chances to succeed in the Suit and if the order passed by the Trial Court is not suspended, the petitioner will be put to suffer irreparable loss and hence, requested for interim suspension of the Trial Court order dated 05.08.2024 passed in I.A.No.286 of 2024 in O.S.No.160 of 2016.

As seen from the record, the document which was sought to be impounded, was permitted by the Trial Court to be sent to the District Registrar for collection of required stamp duty though the revision petitioner/plaintiff opposed for the same on the ground that the said document was forged and created fraudulently.

Considering the above facts and circumstances, this Court is inclined to grant interim suspension of the Trial Court order to a limited period which is upto 13.09.2024.

Hence, there shall be interim suspension of the operation of the impugned order dated 05.08.2024 passed in I.A.No.286 of 2024 in O.S.No.160 of 2016, on the file of the Court of Prl.Senior Civil Judge, Mahabubnagar, till 13.09.2024.
