ATLA ABHINANDHAN REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly, one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the Impugned Letter issued by respondent No.5 herein vide Lr.No. AAE/OP/Cheriya Town/F.No./D.No.86/ 2026-27, dated 27-06-2026, whereby the said respondent No.5 had disconnected the existing Electricity Connection Service of the Petitioners bearing Service Nos. 1301101692 and 1301100146, in respect of his agriculture land admeasuring Acs.7-27 Gts., in Sy.No.1194/B, situated at Musthiyala Village, Cheriya Mandal, Siddipet District, erroneously, without issuing any notice and without conducting any enquiry, as being illegal, arbitrary, without any authority or jurisdiction apart from being in gross violation of principles of natural justice and

contrary to the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003, as well as the provisions of the Telangana Electricity Reform Act, 1998 and Rules made thereunder besides violating Petitioners rights guaranteed under Articles 14, 19(1)(g), 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and Consequently be pleased to a. set aside/quash the impugned letter issued by respondent No.5 vide Lr.No. AAE/OP/ Cheriya Town/F.No./D.No.86/ 2026-27, dated 27-06-2026 b. direct the respondent No.5 to restore the electricity supply for Service Nos. 1301101692 & 1301100146

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. ATLA ABHINANDHAN REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
