T V KALYAN SINGH Advocate for the Petitioner, Additional PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the respondent No. 1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No. 2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to STAY all further proceedings in STC no. 93 OF 2025 on the file of Special Judicial First Class Magistrate for Mobile Judge at Nizamabad including appearance of the petitioner/Accused, pending disposal of CRLP No 10194 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks time for getting instructions and to proceed with the matter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 as well as on the learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2 before the trial Court in STC.No.93 of 2025 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Mr.T.V.Kalyan Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that respondent No.2 filed private complaint against M/s.R.C.Bio-Pesticides represented by its proprietor Mr.Rajendra Chechani, S/o.Radheshyam Chechani for the offences under Sections 138 and 142 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. The learned trial Court without taking into consideration the reply notice dated 21.12.2024 given by the petitioner pursuant to the statutory legal notice issued by respondent No.2 taken cognizance and issued summons especially to the petitioner/Mr.Rajendra Chechani, S/o.Radheshyam Chechani who was never the proprietor of M/s.R.C.Seeds And Bio-Pesticides and it is Mr.Ram Chandra Kanjar, who is the Director of M/s.R.C.Seeds And Bio-Pesticides. Hence, continuation of proceedings against the petitioner is clear abuse of process of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the matter before the trial Court is at the stage of 'for appearance' of the petitioner.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, require detailed examination.



The presence of the petitioner namely Mr.Rajendra Chechani, S/o.Radheshyam Chechani, is dispensed with, before the trial Court. However, the petitioner shall represent the matter through his counsel on every date of hearing.
