Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS, declaring the consequential inaction of the 2nd and 3rd Respondents in considering the petition dated 06/06/2026 made by the Petitioner as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14 and 21 of Constitution of India, the statutory provisions of Sections 329 and 308 of BNS Act, 2023 read with the provisions of the Telangana Medicare Service Persons Act, 2008 apart from being in violation of the principles of natural justice and fair play and consequently to direct the 2nd and 3rd Respondents to grant protection to the Petitioner and the Petitioner herein from the Unofficial Respondents and such other entities/individuals/groups that are

acting detrimental to the interest of the Petitioner and its patients and their assets preserved in the Laboratories of the Petitioner herein and also restraining the print/electronic/social media from acting as the henchmen of the unofficial respondents herein from disrupting with the operations of Dr. Padmaja Fertility Center in any manner whatsoever apart from disrupting the doctors and staff working with the Petitioner in any manner whatsoever.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 2nd and 3rd Respondents to grant protection to the Petitioner and the Petitioner herein from the Unofficial Respondents and such other entities/individuals/groups that are acting detrimental to the interest of the Petitioner and its patients and their assets preserved in the Laboratories of the Petitioner herein and also restraining the print/electronic/social media from acting as the henchmen of the unofficial respondents herein from disrupting with the operations of Dr. Padmaja Fertility Center in any manner whatsoever apart from disrupting the doctors and staff working with the Petitioner in any manner whatsoever, pending disposal of WP No 22160 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI M.V.B.S NARASIMHA ANUDEEP Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents No. 1 to 3, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at the instance of respondents No.4, certain persons attacked the petitioner- hospital/Fertility Centre, causing damage to the laboratory and to some gametes preserved therein. It is further submitted that, even yesterday, the Manager of petitioner-hospital and his family members received threatening calls stating that they would be attacked if they did not agree to a compromise. In view of thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks police protection for the petitioner-hospital.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home seeks further time to get instructions in the matter.

Till such time, the respondent police are directed to provide police protection to the property and personnel of petitioner-hospital at the hospital.
