ORDER:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in connected matters, this Court passed an interim order dated 08.07.2026 in I.A.No.1 of 2026 in W.P.No.20928 of 2026. In view of the same, learned counsel requested this Court to pass similar interim order in this matter also.

On the other hand, learned Standing Counsel appearing for the respondent No.2-TGPSC did not dispute the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner with regard to the interim order dated 08.07.2026 passed in I.A.No.1 of 2026 in W.P.No.20928 of 2026.

In view of the interim order dated 08.07.2026 passed in I.A.No.1 of 2026 in W.P.No.20928 of 2026 and also the Judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in W.A.No.595 of 2023 dated 10.06.2023, there shall be interim direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner to participate in the selection process by receiving the application filed by the petitioner in pursuance of Notification No.01/G/RB/2026 dated 02.06.2026 issued by the respondent No.2, for the post of Assistant Executive Engineer (Civil), but the result of the petitioner may not be declared until further orders from this Court. It is made clear that the petitioner shall not claim any equity on the permission being given to write the examination.
