Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the actions of respondents in not considering the claim of the petitioner for promotion as Revenue Officer / Manager, without reference to long pending disciplinary proceedings vide GO Rt 478, M.A & UD (Vig. I(2)) Dept., Dt 21/06/2018, as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, contrary to law and consequently direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner by promoting him as Revenue Officer / Manager, from the post of Senior Asst on par with the Junior Officers who were already promoted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Revenue Officer / Manager from the post of the Senior Asst on par with Juniors in terms of GO Ms No. 257 (GAD (ser-C)) Dept., Dt 10-06-1999 and G.O.Ms No. 679, GAD (Ser-C) Dept dt 01-11-2008, pending disposal of WP No 22122 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI M.M. ALI Advocate for the Petitioner and AGP FOR SERVICES I appearing for the Respondents, the Court made the following.

Pending further orders, there shall be interim direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Revenue Officer/Manager, as and when the promotions take place, without reference to the pendency of the departmental proceedings in charge memo vide G.O. Rt. No. 478, Municipal Administration and Urban Development (Vig.I(2)) Department, dated 21.06.2018 issued by the respondent no.1.
