ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 480 & 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') by the petitioner/accused No.2 seeking enlargement on bail in connection with Crime No.349 of 2026 of Miyapur Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate. The offences alleged against the petitioner are punishable under Sections 8(c) read with 22(C), 27 of Narcotic Drugs Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

2. In the present case, an interested person, who is a relative of the petitioner, has filed an affidavit stating that Sri P. Vikas Raj, learned counsel on record has been continuously calling him without

any authorisation or engagement from his side and claiming that he would manage the Court. He has further stated that he never engaged, instructed, authorised or appointed learned counsel on record for the petitioner, to appear on his behalf or to file any bail application before this Court.

3. In view of the averments made in the said affidavit, the Registry is directed to place the matter before the Hon'ble the Chief Justice for appropriate action against Sri P. Vikas Raj, learned counsel on record for the petitioner.

4. At this stage, Sri P. Vikas Raj, learned counsel for the petitioner, sought permission of this Court to withdraw the Criminal Petition. However, no endorsement to that effect has been made on the case bundle.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed.

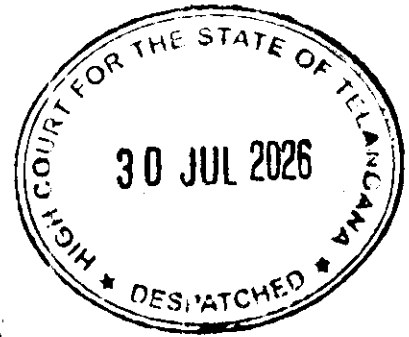
