Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents Nos. 4 and 5 as illegal, arbitrary, a dereliction of duty according to established principles of law, and consequently direct the respondents Nos. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent No. 6, and also to grant police protection to petitioner who is a senior citizen aged 76 years.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct respondents Nos. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the civil disputes between the petitioner and respondent No. 6 and not to obstruct essential repair works of the flat No. 601, pending disposal of WP No 21332 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
