REPRESENTING SRI G. VAMSHI KRISHNA Advocate for the Appellant, SRI G. HEMANTH NETHA, REPRESENTING SRI G. VENKAT RAMANA, for the Respondent No.1 and SRI MURALIDHAR REDDY KATRAM, GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents no. 2 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned counsel Sri K.V.R.Jaya Simha, representing learned counsel Sri G.Vamshi Krishna, appears for the appellants.

Learned counsel Sri G.Hemant Netha, representing learned counsel Sri G.Venkat Ramana, appears for respondent No.1.

Sri Muralidhar Reddy Katram, learned Government Pleader for Revenue, appears for respondents No.2 to 5.

The impugned judgment was passed by the learned writ court in W.P.No.17610 of 2025 on 24.06.2025 without notice to respondents No.5 and 6 therein, who are the appellants herein, with a direction to the respondent authorities to pass a reasoned order on the application of the writ petitioner, who is respondent No.1 herein, for correction of entries in the revenue records under the provisions of the Telangana Bhu Bharati (Record of Rights in Land) Act, 2025, concerning the subject land. The impugned direction has led to passing of an order dated 19.12.2025 which has adversely affected the interests of the appellants who state that the said proceedings were without any notice to them. The appellants have further stated that there are two pending writ petitions relating to the same subject matter by the same writ petitioner.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for the official respondents is allowed two weeks time to obtain instructions after verifying the records from the concerned authorities.

List the matter on 23.07.2026.

Till then, *status quo* as regards the subject property be maintained.
