Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the inaction of the part of the Respondent No.5 herein in filing the Report to the Hon'ble Court of II Additional Junior Civil Judge -cum- X Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally in relation with Criminal S.R. No. 5718 of 2025 is illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violation of Principles of Natural Justice, violation of fundamental rights guaranteed under Article 14 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 5th Respondent herein to enquire into the Complaint of the Petitioner herein and file the Report to the Hon'ble Court of II Additional Junior Civil Judge -cum- X Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally in relation with Criminal S.R.No. 5718 of 2025 as early as possible.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the 5th Respondent herein to enquire into the Complaint of the Petitioner herein and file the Report to the Hon'ble Court of ' II Additional Junior Civil Judge -cum- X Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally in relation with Criminal S.R.No. 5718 of 2025 as early as possible, pending disposal of WP No 21735 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri K Sai Babu Advocate for the Petitioner and GP For Home for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the complaint lodged by the petitioner on 01.08.2025 was not taken into consideration by the Station House Officer, Madhapur Police Station, and therefore, the petitioner was constrained to approach the Court of the II Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-X Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Kukatpally, by way of a private complaint. It is further submitted that the said private complaint was referred to the Station House Officer, Madhapur Police Station, *vide* Lr.Dis.No.05/2026, dated 03.01.2026, with a direction to investigate and file his submissions by 29.01.2026. In spite of the said direction, no action was taken by the respondent police. Therefore, this Writ Petition has been filed.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home has furnished a copy of the written instructions received by him and submitted that the petitioner has lodged another complaint on 05.08.2026, pursuant to which F.I.R.No.1177 of 2026, dated 05.08.2026, was registered. It is further submitted that the registration of the F.I.R. was reported to the trial Court *vide* letter dated 12.08.2026. A copy of the said F.I.R. has also been furnished before this Court. Therefore, according to the learned Assistant Government Pleader, there is compliance with the directions of the trial Court and the F.I.R. has been registered.

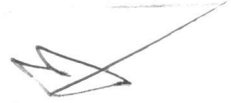
However, this Court finds that the trial Court had referred the private complaint for investigation and submission of a report *vide* letter dated

03.01.2026. It appears that the respondent police did not take any action on the said private complaint pursuant to the direction of the trial Court until a fresh complaint is received by them on 05.08.2026. The failure to act upon the private complaint referred by the trial Court amounts to Contempt of Courts Act. Therefore, the concerned officer is directed to explain the reasons for not taking action on the private complaint referred to by the trial Court.
