Mr. S.Rahul Reddy, learned Special Government Pleader attached to the office of learned Additional Advocate General appears for respondent Nos.1 to 3. G.O.Ms.No.186 dated 08.10.2023 issued by Health, Medical and Family Welfare (A) Department so far as it introduces compulsory contribution to the Employees Health Scheme and G.O.Ms.No.79, Finance (TFR) Department dated 29.06.2026 insofar as it directs compulsory deduction of 1.5% of Basic Pay/Basic Pension towards Employees Health Scheme Fund from the salaries and pensions of Government employees and pensioners are under challenge as being in contravention of the Andhra Pradesh Integrated Medical Attendance Rules, 1972, which holds the field in the successor State of Telangana as well. Petitioner has also sought consequential relief of refund on quashing of the impugned G.O.s. He is working in the District Leprosy Office, Medical and Health Department, Adilabad District as Lab Technician. Learned counsel for the petitioner has also referred to G.O.Ms.No.32 dated 03.11.2014 and series of further orders issued between that date till 2025 which direct the scheme of reimbursement and Employees Health Scheme to continue in parallel. He has also referred to G.O.Ms.No.67 of the Department dated 02.04.2025	

		extending both schemes till further orders without reference to G.O.Ms.No.186 dated 08.10.2023. In this background, petitioner has approached this Court for relief. Learned Special Government Pleader for the State seeks and is allowed two weeks' time to obtain instructions. List the matter on 03.08.2026. HCJ (AKrS,J) GMM,J KL	
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
