WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI V T KALYAN presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the F.I.R. No. 606 of 2026, dt. 24-6-2026 on the file of the P.S. Keesara, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, registered U/Secs. 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) r/w 3(5) BNS, in the interest of justice;

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and the order of the High Court dated 08.07.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI V T KALYAN Advocate for the Petitioner, ADDITIONAL PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

You viz;

are directed to show cause on or before 11.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

**I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026**

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings, including arrest of the petitioner in F.I.R. No.606 of 2026, dt. 24-6-2026 on the file of the P.S. Keesara, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, registered U/Secs. 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2) r/w 3(5) BNS pending disposal of CRLP No 10415 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

**ORDER**

**Notice before admission.**

**Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.**

**Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.**

**Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offences and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations levelled in the complaint, the ingredients of the offences punishable under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 338, 336(3) and 340(2) r/w Section 3(5) of the**

Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioner. He further submits that the allegations are purely civil in nature and arising out of the alleged non-payment of the balance sale consideration in respect of the sale transaction dated 27.01.2025. He further submits that subsequent to the cancellation of the said Sale Deed, the petitioner executed another registered Sale Deed on 21.05.2025. There was no dishonest intention on the part of the petitioner at the time of executing either of the said documents in favour of respondent No. 2. He further submits that respondent No. 2 ought to have approached the competent Civil Court for recovery of the alleged amount due, on the other hand, filed the present criminal petition by giving criminal colour. Therefore, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 11.08.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused in F.I.R.No.606 of 2026 of Keesara Police Station, Medchal-Malkajgiri District.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
