In the meanwhile, the Registry is directed to call for records from the trial Court and prepare a paper book by the next date of hearing. <u>SKS, J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2026</u> Dispensed with for the present. <u>I.A.No.2 of 2026</u> This Interlocutory Application is filed with a prayer to enlarge the petitioner-appellant-accused on bail by suspending the sentence imposed <i>vide</i> judgment dated 17.06.2026 in S.C.No.309 of 2020 passed by the learned Fast Track Special Judge for Trial and Disposal of Rape and POCSO Act Cases, Ranga Reddy District at Rajendranagar, wherein the petitioner was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 75 of JJ Act and was sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three years and to pay fine of Rs.1,000/-.	

	Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that though there is no evidence on record to prove the guilt of the petitioner, the trial Court erroneously convicted the petitioner. He further submitted that the petitioner filed an application before the trial Court for suspension of the sentence and the trial Court suspended the sentence and that the petitioner is having good grounds to succeed in the appeal. Therefore, he prayed the Court to allow the petition. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail petition, contending that there is no illegality in the judgment of the trial Court and the trial Court rightly sentenced the petitioner and that there are no merits in the petition and prayed the Court to dismiss the petition. Perused the contents of the affidavit filed in support of the petition. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, it is considered fit to suspend the sentence of imprisonment alone imposed against the petitioners till the disposal of the Appeal. Accordingly, the sentence of imprisonment alone is suspended and the petitioner is directed to	
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		be released on bail on the same terms and conditions as imposed by the trial Court. During the period of bail, the petitioner shall not indulge in any criminal acts, failing which the respondent – State shall be at liberty to file a petition for cancellation of bail. <u>SKS, J</u> ss	
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
