Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 4th Respondent in interfering with the civil disputes pending between the petitioners and the Respondent No.5, summoning the petitioners to the Police Station and compelling them to vacate the schedule premises and hand over possession to the Respondent No.5 without following due process of law, as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent police authorities not to interfere in the civil dispute between the petitioners and the respondent No.5 except in accordance with law.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant interim order directing respondent police authorities not to interfere in the civil dispute between the petitioners and the respondent No.5 except in accordance with law, pending disposal of WP No 21451 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.
