WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI D. BALA KISHAN RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature Writ of Mandamus, declaring the impugned G.O. Rt. No. 50, Home (Ser.II) Department, dated 20-1-2025 according permission to regularize the services of Head Constables (Civil) w.e.f. 15-2-2018 and its consequential orders issued by the 3rd respondent in Z.O. No. 471/25, C.No. E3-73/Estt/Promotion/Zone-II Basara-25, dated 30-12-2025, altering the dates of regularization of the petitioners to subsequent dates i.e. 29-12-2023, 8-2-2024 and 8-2-2024 respectively though they were promoted and discharging their duties as Head Constables (Civil) from 15-

12-1988 even without following the principles of natural justice including issuing notice and affording opportunity to the petitioners is as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, contrary to rules, violative of Articles 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India besides being opposed to all principles of natural justice, equity and fair play and consequently set-aside the same with all consequential and attendant benefits.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI D. BALA KISHAN RAO Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR SERVICES (HOME) for the Respondents No. 1 to 5 directed issue of notice to the Respondents No. 6 to 8 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
