Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct stay the operation of the impugned G.O. Rt. No. 50, Home (Ser.II) Department, dated 20-1-2025

including the orders issued by the 3rd respondent in Z.O. No. 471/25, C.No. E3-73/Estt/Promotion/Zone-II Basara-25, dated 30-12-2025, pending disposal of WP No 21572 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

ORDER:

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader for Services (Home) appearing for the respondent Nos.1 to 5. Perused the material on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that G.O.Rt.No.50, Home (Services-II) Department, 20.01.2025 is the subject matter of W.P.No.24022 of 2025 and this Court directed the official respondents therein not to proceed further in pursuance of the said G.O.Rt. pertaining to Zone-VI *vide* interim order dated 19.08.2025. The respondent Nos.3 to 5 herein are parties to the said Writ Petition and despite the same, the respondent authorities have proceeded further in pursuance of the said G.O.Rt. by issuing consequential orders pertaining to Zone-II *vide* C.No.E3-73/Estt/Promotion/Zone-II Basara-25, Z.O.No.471/25, dated 30.12.2025 issued by the respondent No.1. In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to pass a similar order in the present Writ Petition.

On the other hand, the learned Government Pleader for Services (Home), basing on the written instructions, submits that, pursuant to the Common Judgment passed by this Court in W.P.No.4646 of 2018 and Batch dated 25.01.2022 and G.O.Rt.No.50, Home (Services-II) Department, 20.01.2025, the respondent No.1 passed the consequential orders dated 30.12.2025. Consequently, learned Government Pleader seeks time to file counter.

After hearing both sides and on a perusal of the entire material on record, this Court is of the considered view that, in the connected matter in W.P.No.24022 of 2025, this Court passed interim orders dated 19.08.2025 and in view of the same, this is a fit case for granting interim orders by directing the official respondents not to proceed further in pursuance of G.O.Rt.No.50, Home (Services-II) Department, 20.01.2025 and the consequential orders dated 30.12.2025.

Accordingly, there shall be interim direction to the official respondents not to proceed further in pursuant of G.O.Rt.No.50, Home (Services-II) Department, 20.01.2025 and the consequential orders issued by the respondent No.1 *vide* C.No.E3-73/Estt/Promotion/Zone-II Basara-25, Z.O.No.471/25, dated 30.12.2025 issued by the respondent No.1.
