Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents, more particularly Respondent Nos.2 to 4 herein, in trying to interfere, seize and demolish the Petitioners property bearing municipal No.18-13-18, admeasuring 2360.00 Sq. Yards or 1973.20 Sq. Meters, consisting of Ground plus upper 7 Floors in Sy.No.62/2 and 62/3, Town Sy.No.8, situated at M.M Colony, Bandlaguda, Keshavagiri, Hyderabad, Telangana, despite the pendency of BRS Application Ref. No. 2000098062 dated 29-01-2016, as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and Consequently to direct the Respondents herein not to interfere, seize and demolish the Petitioner's property bearing municipal No.18-13-18, admeasuring 2360.00 Sq. Yards or 1973.20 Sq. Meters, consisting of Ground plus upper 7 Floors in Sy.No.62/2 and 62/3, Town Sy.No.8, situated at M.M Colony, Bandlaguda, Keshavagiri, Hyderabad, Telangana, pending disposal of BRS Application Ref. No.2000098062 dated 29-01-2016;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents herein not to interfere, seize and demolish the Petitioners property bearing municipal No.18-13-18, admeasuring 2360.00 Sq. Yards or 1973.20 Sq. Meters, consisting of Ground + upper 7 Floors in Sy.No.62/2 and 62/3, Town Sy.No.8, situated at M.M Colony, Bandlaguda, Keshavagiri, Hyderabad, Telangana pending disposal of BRS Application Ref. No. 2000098062 dated 29-01-2016, pending disposal of WP No.21450 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit in support thereof and the order of the High Court dated 06.07.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, Senior Counsel representing Sri Katika Ravinder Reddy, Advocate for the Petitioner, Government Pleader For M.A & U.D for the Respondent No.1 and Sri Mohd, Imran Khan, Additional Advocate General, for the Respondent Nos.2 to 4, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Mr. Vijay Gopal, appearing as party-in-person, filed application in I.A. No.2 of 2026 seeking permission of this Court to implead him as respondent No.5 to this writ petition. He stated that he is party interested and petitioner in W.P. No.11130 of 2026.

Heard Mr. B. Mayur Reddy, learned senior counsel, appearing for Mr. Katika Ravinder Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Mohd. Imran Khan, learned Addl. Advocate General, appearing for respondent Nos.2 to 4, and Mr. Vijay Gopal, party-in-person.

Mr. Vijay Gopal - party-in-person stated that instant writ petition has been filed without disclosing that action is sought to be taken by respondent authorities against unauthorized constructions made by the petitioners, in compliance of the order passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court in W.P. No.11130 of 2026 dated 30.04.2026. Mr. Vijay Gopal - party-in-person submitted that dispute involved therein is regarding encroachment of Full Tank Level (FTL) of Salkam Cheruvu. Orders have been passed in the said writ petition directing respondent authorities therein to take action, not only to remove encroachments from the water body but also to shift the students studying in the educational institutions running in the subject property to other Government schools and colleges.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that there was no suppression of material facts. In fact in paragraph No.6 of the writ affidavit it was disclosed that W.P. No.11130 of 2026 is pending and interim orders have been passed in the said writ petition.

Learned Addl. Advocate General submitted that Mr. Vijay Gopal - party-in-person does not have any locus standi to implead in this writ petition. W.P. No.11130 of 2026 is listed today and compliance report is yet to be filed by concerned authorities.

This Court passed order dated 06.07.2026 in this writ petition taken up as lunch motion without going into the merits of the case and without reference to any of the averments made in the writ petition. No doubt the affidavit mentions that W.P. No.11130 of 2026 is filed. However, at the time of passing of above order, learned standing counsel for GHMC has not informed this Court about detailed order passed in W.P. No.11130 of 2026.

In the considered opinion of this Court, it would not be appropriate for this Court to pass orders, more so, when order dated 06.07.2026 may be in conflict with the order dated 30.04.2026 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in W.P. No.11130 of 2026.

In view of the above, without going into the merits on the allegations made by Mr. Vijay Gopal - party-in-person, as a matter of propriety, order dated 06.07.2026 passed by this Court is recalled.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case.
