WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI JEERIPOTHULA SRINIVAS presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in sending an e-mail letter dated 16-06-2025, rejecting the candidature of the Petitioner for appointment of retail outlet (Petrol Pump) Dealership in Hayathnagar to Vanasthalipuram JN on NH-65 ONLHS, Ranga Reddy District, when already the respondents provisionally selected the Petitioner, by not considering the correctly mentioned the land documents, which was submitted physically to the respondents, even though in the said rejection letter, the Petitioner can make representation even though he has made the representation in pursuance of the said instructions, is nothing but arbitrary, illegal, null and void and violative of principles of natural justice and also violative of Articles 14, 19 and 21 of the Constitution of India and set aside the same, in so far it relates to rejecting the

candidature of appointment of retail outlet (Petrol Pump) Dealership in Hayathnagar to Vanasthalipuram JN on NH-65 ONLHS, Ranga Reddy District is concerned and consequently direct the respondents to consider the case of the Petitioner for appointment of retail outlet (Petrol Pump) Dealership in Hayathnagar to Vanasthalipuram JN on NH-65 ONLHS, Ranga Reddy District as per his selection by duly taking into consideration of the correctly mentioned land documents, which was already physically submitted to the respondents.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI. JEERIPOTHULA SRINIVAS Advocate for the Petitioner, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
