Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents more particularly respondent No.5 herein in not conducting fair and transparent investigation by considering the documents submitted by the petitioner on 07-06-2026, and filing of charge sheet pertaining to FIR No.57 of 2025 dated 10-02-2025, registered U/s 420, 467, 471, 506 r/w 34 IPC on the file of Malakpet Police Station as illegal, arbitrary in violation of article 14, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India besides being in violation of principles of natural justice and consequently to direct the respondents herein more particularly respondent No.5 herein to conduct fair and transparent investigation by considering the documents submitted by the petitioner on 07-06-2026 and file charge sheet forthwith, pertaining to FIR No.57 of 2025 dated 10-02-2025, registered U/s 420, 467, 471, 506 r/w 34 IPC on the file of Malakpet Police Station,

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Katika Ravinder Reddy Advocate for the Petitioner, Gp For Home for the Respondents, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

The written instructions furnished by the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home only state that a fair investigation is being carried out. However, the instructions do not disclose the steps taken by the respondent police in the course of investigation, in spite of more than one and a half years has been passed after registration of the FIR.

For filing proper written instructions, list this matter on 22.07.2026 in the Adjourned Motion List.

If proper instructions are not furnished by the next date of hearing, respondent No.5 shall be present before this Court on 22.07.2026 along with records.
