WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI M. AJAY KUMAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 3rd respondent in passing the Award and trying to pay the compensation amount in favour of. the unofficial respondents 5 to 9 without referring the matter to the authority constituted under Section 52 of the Act by duly depositing the compensation amount with the authority under Section 78 (2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 in connection with the petitioner agrl lands in Sy No. 140 (Ac.1.20 gts) belongs to 1st petitioner, Sy No. 74/0/1/1 (Ac.0.02 gts) belongs to 2nd petitioner, Sy No.74/J/1/1 (Ac.0.0480 gts) belongs to 3rd petitioner and Sy No. 140 (Ac.0.10 gts) belong to 4th petitioner, all the lands situated at Nakkalapalli Revenue Village Shivar, Khila Warangal Mandal, Warangal District inspite of the objections of the petitioners filed through legal notice dated 22.05.2026 is illegal and void and opposed to Article, 14, 19, 21 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently to direct the respondents 2 to 5 to refer the matter under Section 65 of the Act to the authority constituted under Section 52 of the Act by duly depositing the compensation amount in the tribunal till the disputes are resolved in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI M. AJAY KUMAR Advocate for the Petitioners and AGP FOR LAND ACQUISITION for the Respondents no. 1 to 4 directed issue of notice to the Respondents No. 5 to 9 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
