Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly a Writ in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents no. 4 in interfering with the personal liberty of the petitioner by calling him to the police station regularly and compelling the petitioner to settle the civil disputes with respondents 5 and 6 by paying the amount as demanded by them as illegal, arbitrary, unjust, abuse of process of law and consequently direct the respondents no. 4 not to interfere with the personal liberty of the petitioner and not to call the petitioner to the police station in relation to the civil disputes, in the interest of justice.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be

pleased to direct the respondents no. 4 not to interfere with the personal liberty of the petitioner and not to call the petitioner to the police station in relation to the civil disputes, in the interest of justice, pending disposal of WP No 21586 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri S Surender Reddy Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 4, the Court made the following.

List this matter on 13.07.2026 in the Adjourned Motion List.

Till such time, respondents No.1 to 4 are directed not to call the petitioner or his family members to the Police Station without there being any justifiable cause.
