Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a Writ of Mandamus, declaring

- (i) the action of Respondent No.4 i.e., the Tahsildar, Ghatkesar Mandal, in issuing the impugned memo bearing No. B/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026, directing the Respondent No.5 i.e., the Mandal Surveyor to demarcate Bandla Bata(Cart Track) passing through Petitioner's patta lands in Sy.No. 82 and 83 without issuing notices to the Petitioner for conducting a survey as illegal, highhanded, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violation of principles of natural justice
- (ii) the action of the Respondent No. 4 i.e., the Tahsildar, Ghatkesar Mandal, in issuing letter bearing No. C/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 to the Respondent No. 6 i.e., the Station House Officer to provide police protection during the course of demarcation of alleged Bandla Bata through petitioner's land in Sy.No.82 and 83 without conducting survey as illegal, highhanded, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violation of principles of natural justice and
- (iii) the highhanded and illegal action of Respondents more particularly Respondent No.2 to 6 acting at the behest of Respondent No.7 and interfering with Petitioner's rights and possession over the lands admeasuring Ac.0.30 Gts., in Sy.No.81/E2, Ac.1.20 Gts., in Sy.No.82/AA, and Ac. 0.20 Gts., in Sy.No.83/RU, aggregating to a total extent of Municipality, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District as illegal, highhanded, arbitrary, unconstitutional, violation of principles of natural justice,
- (iv) and to consequently set aside the memo bearing No. B/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 and letter bearing No. C/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 issued by the Respondent No.4 and forthwith direct the Respondents No.2 to 6 not to interfere with the rights and possession of the Petitioner and not to demolish the structures over the Petitioner's land admeasuring Ac.0.30 Gts., in Sy. No. 81/E2, Ac.1.20 Gts., in Sy.No. 82/AA, and Ac. 0.20 Gts., in Sy. No. 83/RU, aggregating to a total extent of Ac.2-00 Gts., situated

at Muthwalliguda Village, Kachivanisingaram, Pocharam Municipality,
Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the memo bearing No. B/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 and letter bearing No. C/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 issued by the Respondent No.4 directing the Respondent No.5&6 to demarcate alleged "Bandla Bata" (Cart Track) passing through Petitioner's patta lands admeasuring Ac.0.30 Gts., in Sy. No. 81/E2, Ac.1.20 Gts., in Sy.No. 82/AA, and Ac. 0.20 Gts., in Sy. ORDER : (ORAL)

Heard Mr. P. Raja Sripathi Rao, learned senior counsel, appearing for Mr. Achyuth Bharatwaj, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Putta Krishna Reddy, learned standing counsel for Municipalities, appearing for respondent No.2, Mr. M. Sahas Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for respondent Nos.3 to 5, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondent No.6, and Mrs. C. Rakee Sridharan, learned counsel for respondent No.7.

2. Grievance of the petitioner is that in the process of conducting survey over the subject land to allegedly protect the twenty one (21) feet Bandla Bata (Cart track) road in Survey Nos.82 and 83 of Muthwelliguda Village, Kachivanisingaram, Pocharam Municipality, Ghatkesar Mandal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, respondent No.4 addressed a letter to respondent No.6 *vide* Lr.No.C/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026 requesting to provide Police protection during the course of demarcation and survey stating that there is every possibility of law and order problem and Police protection is required for smooth execution of survey proceedings.

3. According to learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner, instead of conducting survey respondent No.2 has employed JCB machines and trying to remove the compound wall constructed by the petitioner, as such he is constrained to approach this Court.

4. Learned standing counsel for respondent No.2 submitted that Municipal authorities are not interfering with subject land of the petitioner and no demolition activity is undertaken.

5. In view of the aforesaid submission of learned standing counsel for respondent No.2, this Court is of the opinion that no further orders are required to be passed in this writ petition.

6. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent Nos.4 and 5 to go ahead with survey as directed by this Court by the order dated 21.05.2025 in W.P. No.15179 of 2025, by taking assistance of respondent No.6 as per letter *vide* Lr.No.C/873/2026 dated 30.06.2026. It is made clear that any observation made by this Court in this order shall not have any bearing on the cases pending in this Court or any other Court or authority in respect of the subject land. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any,
pending in the writ petition stand closed.

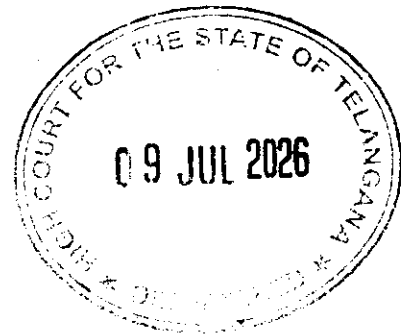
