ORDER

Alleging interference by respondent No.3 in the construction activity of the petitioner over the plot bearing No.575, Eastern Part, admeasuring 137.5 square yards, situated in Survey Nos.94, 95, 96, 97 and 103, situated at Almasguda Village, Balapur Revenue Mandal, Badangpet, Ranga Reddy District, Telangana, in spite of the petitioner being the owner of the property, having purchased the same through registered sale deeds and having obtained the building permission for construction, this writ petition has been filed.

2. The learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on written instructions, submitted that there was a complaint received from one P.S.Sathish Kumar and an FIR has been registered vide FIR No.598/2026, dated 08.05.2026, under Sections 329(4), 351(2) of BNS against the petitioner and others and the investigation is under progress. It is further submitted that during the course of investigation, the officer has visited the scene of offence and also issued a notice under Section 35(3) of BNSS to the petitioner herein/A2 on 27.05.2026 and investigation is under progress. The allegation of the petitioner that respondent No.3 has stopped the construction activities is denied.

3. In view of the above, the respondent police are directed not to interfere with the construction activity of the petitioner provided that the petitioner has got a valid sale deed and construction permission. Since the petitioner denies receipt of a notice under Section 35(3) of BNSS, the petitioner is directed to approach the police within a period of one (1) week from today and

the respondent police shall serve a copy of the notice to the petitioner and thereafter take action strictly in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition, shall stand closed.

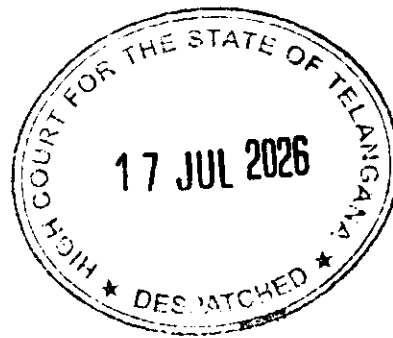
